Chairman Colene Conley called the special meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Present were the trustees, fiscal officer and Kirk Cekada.

Rick explained that he and Kirk met in the park earlier this summer. Kirk is willing to donate some trees to the park. Rick explained about our financial situation and the subject was dropped. Kirk gave us a brief synopsis of his background and the tree nursery business which he is a part of. While he willing to donate the trees, there would be a cost involved with the machine work due to the cost of fuel and wear and tear as well as labor. Colene asked about a plan to be able to add to each year. Kirk said that could be done. He also stated that site selection is important when choosing the kind of trees to be planted.

Bev asked about the cost. Kirk said the tree balls start at 24" and increase in 4" increments. He thought we'd be looking at 24" & 28" balls so it would be about \$25 to \$30 and up, depending on size.

Bill asked about the care. Kirk stated the fall is the best time to plant because the hop is that nothing is needed. However, when there are extra dry summers, like this year, there would need to be watering.

Everyone went outside to view the park for tree placement. Kirk will work up a plan and get back with the trustees.

Colene stated that we should get the newsletter in the residents' hands by September 22nd. Dorothy stated it needs to be to the printer by September 10th or 11th at the absolute latest.

Bev commented about a concern with the Co. Prosecutor's Office reviewing the info pertaining to the levy so we don't cross the line of what we are and aren't allowed to print with township funds. Colene feels as long as we only show where we receive our money and how it is spent, we will be fine. Bev will put something together and e-mail everyone. The newsletter will be on an 11 x 17 page folded in quarters. Rick would like to keep to bullet points for easy reading.
