A special meeting was held at 5:30 p.m., August 22, 2013 called to order by Bill Pavlick at the Mallet Creek Cemetery. Those in attendance were Bill Pavlick, Rick Monroe, Colene Conley and Mike Sweet of Sweet Lawns. This meeting was requested by Mike Sweet to explain what is developing concerning the mowing and maintenance of the cemetery. Mr. Sweet pointed out that the mowing pattern of the current contractor in the cemetery is causing huge ruts around the headstones. The three Trustees agreed and visually made inspections. Top soil will now be required to be brought in to level numerous areas around the cemetery. It is apparent to the Trustees that the same mowing pattern takes place and is definitely what is causing this serious issue. It was also agreed that the contractor is cutting the grass too short. There are huge clumps of dead grass left lying all over areas of the cemetery.

Listed in the contractors mowing contract is the trimming of bushes within the cemetery. During the inspections, a seven foot headstone was discovered, completely surrounded by a wild growing berry bush. The headstone was not even visible. Trustees Conley and Monroe asked Trustee Pavlick if he would kindly speak to the contractor, Mr. Adamsky, concerning his mowing patterns and bush trimming. Trustee Conley as well asked Trustee Pavlick to remind him to trim the hedges in the front of the townhall and to remove the tree growing out the side of the hedge, as well as the huge bush located on the North side of the fire department shed. Trustee Pavlick agreed. Mr. Sweet stated it was not his intention to embarrass another contractor, but with the seriousness of what is taking place within the cemetery, it is necessary to convey his concerns to the Trustees.
