**RESOLUTION #16-04-05 – Approve PO’s, BC’s, Payment of Bills and Payroll**

**Moved** by Monroe, second by Conley to approve the purchase orders, payment of the payroll and bills (Item A attached). Roll: Monroe, yes; Conley, yes; Pavlick, yes.

**Visitors:**

- Mickey Kennedy and Jeff Klaas – brought a banner sign to put in the park for the future site of the Gold Star Families Memorial. Mickey stated he has 2 car dealerships (Liberty and Pat O’Brian) interested in helping. The Coalition of Veterans want something more than the signed minutes so he provided the trustees with a sample. The trustees stated they will need to have Bill Thorne review it before they sign. Mickey would like to do the project in two phases – August or so put in the pavers and foundation and then October do the granite. Milano’s will be doing the monuments and etching. Bill stated that he would not be comfortable with a two phase procedure without all of the money being

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raised up front. Mickey wants to know if he can still do a groundbreaking on May 29<sup>th</sup>. He would like to do the groundbreaking prior to the 3:00 Parade beginning at 1:30. Other areas didn't use contracts or lawyers Mickey stated. Rick stated that we should meet again with Mr. Thorne. Mickey asked if the Gold Star Family name could be integrated into the Park name. It was explained to him that we had requirements to meet with the purchase of the land. Mickey asked if he was able to call OUPS and was told that they only want to do it 10 days prior. He's not to start construction until all of the monies are raised. Mickey would like to have a marker with the trustees names on it. The trustees said they would talk about it. Mickey is sure there will be a monument out there by November 10<sup>th</sup>. He is confident. Colene will get the info to Bill Thorne and check his schedule for a special meeting. Mickey asked again about the sign and Dorothy stated that there is nothing in the code to cover it. It would have to fall under Temporary Signs. It could only be up for 30 days 4 times per calendar year. The trustees told Mickey they want the sign to be back to back perpendicular to the road.

**RESOLUTION #16-04-06 – Waive Zoning Permit Fees for Gold Star Memorial Project**

### Reports:

#### **Fire Department:**

- Chief Barrett gave the trustees a copy of the last month's run report.
- Training – Medina Hospital for EMS training; train cars with HAZMAT training; pump and hose operation training
- Thank the trustees for allowing us to go to FDIC in Indianapolis. We received much good information.
- We were able to finalize some equipment for one of our 2014 Operations Grant which I've given to Colene.

**RESOLUTION #16-04-07 – Purchase Extrication Equipment from Howell Rescue**  
**Moved** by Monroe, second by Conley to purchase extrication equipment from Howell Rescue System for \$16,418. Roll: Monroe, yes; Conley, yes; Pavlick, yes.

**RESOLUTION #16-04-08 – Purchase Extrication from Power Hawk Technologies**  
**Moved** by Monroe, second by Conley to purchase extrication equipment from Power Hawk Technologies for \$2,110. Roll: Monroe, yes; Conley, yes; Pavlick, yes.

- Our ISO rating is now at 5 where hydrants are instead of 6 and 5x instead of 9 where there are no hydrants.
- Smokey and Patches will begin their summer schedule this Saturday.
- The pre-prom accident program is on Wednesday, May 11<sup>th</sup> at 9:30.

#### **Zoning:**

- Dorothy gave the trustees a copy of Eric's proposal for a camera for the park area and the proposal to complete the rack.

**RESOLUTION #16-04-09 – Approve AHEC to add a Camera and Completion of Rack**  
**Moved** by Conley, second by Monroe to approve AHEC to do both the camera (\$585) and completion of the rack (\$510) and have Eric come to train us. Roll: Conley, yes; Monroe, yes; Pavlick, yes.

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- Dorothy gave the trustees a copy of the permits issued since the beginning of the year as well as a report of concerns. (Item B)
- The trustees reviewed the Caudill property change to go before the Commission and had no problems.
- The family of Mr. & Mrs. Christopher Englewood would like to plant a memorial tree. Rick doesn't want responsibility for a tree since they die. Dorothy will call Boyert's for a recommendation on a type of tree and Bill will contact Rusty Oak to see what they would charge.
- A Branch Road resident has a situation with the people on Smith Road holding a shooting club on the weekends. I told her to contact the sheriff's office. They are shooting automatic weapons all day Saturday and Sunday. They now are setting off the cannons in the evening. I've given her the Wildlife contacts. I've also told her to let the neighbors know they should also call the sheriff's office and continue to document it with the sheriff.
- Dorothy read a letter from Mary Lenarth – problems with the tape recorder; tapes are obsolete to this; the trustees said Mary should pick out what she wants; she's asked for a sidewalk between the pavilion and play area; posts for garbage cans to be straightened out; mulch is low; Colene stated that Ken Neumeyer will fix the posts and Rick will fix the electrical outlets. The trustees will check the mulch to see how low it is.

### Trustees:

#### **Rick Monroe:**

- I attended the pipeline seminar which was good.
- Cemetery – no updates on Career Center drawings; Leonard has started working on the cemetery and it looks good so far; we have a trailer that is hard to get moved around that John Kollar brings his tractor up for; He is willing to sell it to us for \$500; Bev asked Rick to confirm with Bill Thorne that we were allowed to do it and not violate the ethics law.
- I spoke with Dan Becker and they will be doing the hot mix first and the chip seal road may be done later in the fall. Dan suggested we have an inspector out there. Bill Pavlick and Rick have spoke with Fred Boreman and he will be the inspector for us.

#### **RESOLUTION #16-04-10 – Hire Fred Boreman as Road Inspector**

**Moved** by Monroe, second by Conley to hire Fred Boreman to be the inspector on our road paving project. Roll: Monroe, yes; Conley, yes; Pavlick, yes.

- I've spoke with Greg Dobson regarding the road culverts that need to be replaced prior to road paving. I'll meet with Greg next week.
- I've received a letter from Flow Landscape regarding treating our pond from May to September for \$750 for the 10 visits.

#### **RESOLUTION #16-04-11 – Hire Flow Landscape for Pond**

**Moved** by Monroe, second by Conley to hire Flow Landscape to treat our pond at a cost of \$750 for 10 visits. Roll: Monroe, yes; Conley, yes; Pavlick, yes.

- I've noticed ants in the bays and called Certified Pest Control which we used last year. I also contacted Terminex (\$240) for bees and ants. I'll wait for next month and call Certified again. I'll contact them about not only the bees and ants, but mice and squirrels.

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- Soil and Water spoke at our County meeting this month and told us the Monarch Butterfly is in danger. I will be planting milkweed seeds.
- I'll contact Ron Pfaff for putting up the flags. There are a couple of really bad flags that need to be replaced. I'll be getting measurements so we can get replacements.
- Last month we agreed to have the dumpster emptied weekly. April was slow so they will do it from May through October. It raise the cost from \$53.13 a month to \$73.40 a month..
- On May 19<sup>th</sup>, our county association meeting's topic will be on cemeteries.
- There was an issue here with the kitchen sink leaking. We couldn't find the leak. For a couple of days, it was ok. Then it was leaking again. The packing nut had a slow leak. Ken Barrett has snugged it up.

### Colene Conley:

- Spieth Road is very alligatored. I have a call in to Dan Becker to see about crack sealing and who did Fenn between Pearl and Hoffman.
- Dorothy received a call from a resident on Elyria Road regarding horses getting loose. Colene will do research on who pays for the fence and get back.
- There is an old yellow house at Gayer and Hamilton whose garage has let loose. Ken has reviewed it and said it is an unsafe structure. Ken will get a sample letter to Colene that the fire department would use on commercial property.
- Matt Behner also wanted to thank the trustees for allowing them to go to FDIC.
- The York School property – the 1 acre parcel Frank Jarem wants to keep has now passed the Health Department. Steve from the Title Co. has dropped it off at the Planning Commission, but Colene needs to go in to sign it.

### Bill Pavlick:

- Station Road by the R/R – took me a while to get in touch with CSX; Most railroads have a 50' right-of-way; they have sent me forms that Greg Dobson needs to fill out before we can fix the hole.
- Great Lakes picked up the porta-john this morning and opened the new restroom.
- Carr Corporation finally put up the solar stacks so we released the check to them.
- I met with Leonard again regarding the sidewalk on the east of the station. He's going to cut out the portion that has sunk and drain it to a catch basin. The cost will be \$300 per day plus materials. Bill will let Bev know how many days.
- Roadside mowing is set up to begin Memorial Weekend.
- The tannonite canons are legal to purchase but illegal to set off, like fireworks.
- I also attended the pipeline seminar and thought it was good too.
- So far, the Got Grass people are doing a great job.
- Great Lakes has agreed to clean the restroom for \$25 each cleaning.

- Dave Hull asked about the Shale Creek maintenance shed and all the equipment that is sitting outside.
