Chairman Bill Pavlick called the special meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. Tim Joyce and Chad Heidecker from Fabrizi Trucking and Dave Hull was present.

Bill stated we were here to discuss the snowplowing. We will be getting another cut in funding from the state per Steve Hambley. In speaking with the Co. Engineer's office, Bill Viovide said they stop running the roads at around 8:00 p.m. and don't begin again until around 4:00 a.m. unless there is an ice storm. Bill stated that he would be retiring in 6 weeks and will be willing to run the roads between 8:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m. if a call comes in from the sheriff's department. Colene asked why Bill was telling the Fabrizi men they wouldn't be plowing as much. I thought we were here to discuss it. Bill stated yes we were and he felt we needed to watch what we do because of lack of funds.

Tim Joyce asked if there were certain areas that need to be addressed better. At times it is difficult to manage and coordinate between the state and county working. Rick asked that the concrete streets be plowed only, not salted. Tim stated they did the intersections in the subdivisions and only hit with salt on the straight way when they start getting packed down.

There was a lot of discussion regarding when to call out the snowplow trucks and when not to. Bill again stated we had to watch when we did the calling because of our money situation. Tim stated that at times the salt from the County is wet because of the county trucks dumping their salt back in the bin. Tim explained about the access to the loader and salt at the County and how they have to be sure to have enough salt for the whole weekend because the County doesn't always have a loader driver.

It was re-iterated that between 8:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m. we would prefer not to have the trucks out unless there is an ice storm. Bill will do the checking and between 8:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m. Rick stated that he didn't want to see them out when there is just a dusting.

We'd love to have a road levy, but without that, we need to watch our funds and be able to do some paving before the roads fall apart. We also have to be cognizant of having the JVS students in our area and Buckeye schools with all the kids driving.

There was discussion regarding a salt bin. Currently, we don't have the funds. There are pro's and con's with using the County Engineer's Highway Department for salt.

Bill told Tim and Chad that they have been doing a good job. We are happy with what you've done. Colene and Rick agreed. Bill will speak with Bill Viovide to see who is the plow driver at Wolff and Abbeyville. Tim told the trustees of the Wolff Road Bridge and how it can ice over very quickly.

Dave Hull told the trustees that the "Cross Traffic does not stop" sign has been stolen from Wolff and Abbeyville. Colene will contact the County.
