Chairman Rick Monroe called the special meeting to order at 4.00 p.m. Also present, William Pavlick, Todd Zieja. Guests: Tim Joyce, Frank Fabrizi, Emil Fabrizi from Fabrizi Trucking.

Rick stated that the reason for the meeting was to discuss the upcoming plowing season. Rick stated that we need your help to reign in the cost. Pavlick asked Tim if they were plowing on the same schedule as the county. Tim stated "For the most part." Pavlick asked how much salt per lane mile they were using. Pavlick stated that the county uses about 200 lb per lane mile. Todd asked Fabrizi if they could reduce the salt usage by 20%? Tim stated that they would try. Rick told them that the roads do not have to be snow free, but the intersections should be clear. Pavlick told Tim that last winter was very costly for the township between what the state took from the township and the hard winter; this has made the budget very tight. Emil asked if we wanted to go street by street. We told him that was not necessary, just to take care of the problem areas that we already are aware of.
