Chairman William Pavlick called the special meeting to order at 5:00pm for the purpose of discussing extending the execution of the contract for Collection, Transportation and Deliver for Disposal or Processing Residential Solid Waste and Recyclable Materials Generated in and Collected from Residential Units in York Township and Township Facilities, and other business brought before the trustees. After the pledge of allegiance, Chairman Pavlick announced the meeting was being taped for transcription purposes only.

RESOLUTION #19-10-01 accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the budget Commission, authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the county auditor. Moved by Trustee Monroe, second by Trustee Pavlick. Roll: Monroe, yes; Pavlick, yes.

RESOLUTION #19-10-02 Extending the execution of the contract for collection, transportation and deliver for disposal or processing of residential solid waste and recyclable materials generated in and collected from residential units in York township and township facilities. (Attached) Moved by Trustee Monroe, second by Trustee Pavlick. Roll: Monroe, yes; Pavlick, yes.

RESOLUTION #19-10-03 Moved by Monroe, Second by Pavlick to approve Chief Ken Barrett and Assistant Chief Jason Creamer to have use of township Huntington credit cards for approved purchases for the fire department. Roll: Monroe, yes; Pavlick, yes.

Trustee Zieja arrived at 5:05.

Due to the prosecutor vacation, the contract will not be ready for execution and the date of signing is postponed until October 30, 2019 at 5pm.

Sarah Mathews distributed a (very) rough draft letter to go out to the residents for the Trustees to look over for anything they would like added or changed. Sarah asked this not be circulated until we have a finalized version. She would like to meet in a week with a point person for a workshop to finalize the letter language before the contract meeting. The final product will be release to the public. Wednesday October 16, at 2:30 at the York Township Complex, Trustee Pavlick will meet with Sarah and Beth to review all the items and set dates and edits. At contract execution, she will have the implementation plan ready for approval. Since the trustees have the draft, if there are any changes they would like to see, please send her an email. The working copy is subject to many edits.

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Trustee Zieja would like the opt-out information in a digital copy so he can place it on the website. He will absolutely have a copy, but Sarah stated the mailer piece needs to be delivered first, to educate everyone on processes and procedures. Once residents are informed, they will have plenty of time to make a decision as to which service option to choose, or if they want to do the paperwork to opt out. The opt-out dates are tentatively scheduled for January 1 – 31, 2020. These dates are better than in December so the information is not overlooked during the business of the holidays. Opt out must be renewed annually, 30 days before the contract date.

A resident asked if there would be a hardship opt out. Not as a specific reason.

Will there be township recycling? No, that creates a large mess, but the current recycling bins placed around the township will remain in place. We collaborate with the local schools. Also with the new plan, we will have curbside recycling.

Will people have to notify their trash hauler of the last date of service? Beth replied that the trustees will be provided with an example of a cease and desist letter they can modify to send to all trash haulers informing them the last day of service will be March 1, 2019. Billing cycles should not be extended beyond that date. Service with Rumpke is scheduled to start March 2, 2020. Sarah asked if we had a township logo to put on the letter. We do not. Volunteers are welcome to collaborate on a logo if desired. She will be given the website information.

Trustee Monroe made the motion to adjourn, second by Trustee Zieja. Roll: Monroe, yes; Zieja, yes; Pavlick, yes. Meeting adjourned 5:25pm.

WHEREAS, on Thursday, September 26, 2019, the Trustees of York Township recommended the bid for the **Collection, Transportation And Delivery For Disposal Or Processing Of Residential Solid Waste And Recyclable Materials Generated In And Collected From Residential Units In York Township, And Township Facilities** be awarded to Rumpke Waste and Recycling Services; and

WHEREAS, the Invitation to Bid for **Collection, Transportation And Delivery For Disposal Or Processing Of Residential Solid Waste And Recyclable Materials Generated In And Collected From Residential Units In York Township, And Township Facilities** required the contract be executed by October 10, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees of York Township and Rumpke Waste and Recycling Services have agreed via e-mail to extend the contract execution date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Trustees of York Township of Medina County Ohio, with the mutual agreement of Rumpke Waste and Recycling Services, that:

The execution date for the contract for the **Collection, Transportation And Delivery For Disposal Or Processing Of Residential Solid Waste And Recyclable Materials Generated In And Collected From Residential Units In York Township, And Township Facilities** and associated Implementation Schedule, be extended through and until October 30, 2019.
