Chairman William Pavlick called the special meeting to order at 6:30pm for the purpose of discussing submitted bid documents for the Collection, Transportation and Deliver for Disposal or Processing Residential Solid Waste and Recyclable Materials Generated in and Collected from Residential Units in York Township and Township Facilities. Trash Bids were submitted by representatives of the following waste management companies: Rumpke, Republic Services, Kimble. After the pledge of allegiance, Chairman Pavlick announced the meeting was being taped for transcription purposes only and turned the meeting over to Beth Biggins-Ramer, MCSWD.

Beth compiled all the information on the pricing information for unlimited service, factor adjustment formula, and bag service and sent it to the Trustees for discussion and analysis of the bids as submitted. Unlimited service includes the two carts provided initially (1 recycling 64 gal cart and one regular cart, 96 gal), and 2 cubic yards (includes additional bags, bulky items, essentially anything you want) each week. Additional carts may be rented or exchanged depending on preference (fee schedule attached.) Totals were as follows: Kimble \$21.99 per month, Republic 20.19 per month and Rumpke \$19.65 per month. The Processing fee factor was discussed. If the MCSWD raises or lowers the tipping fee price, (which is a very slow process), trash haulers provided a formula to adjust this number. The bid number also assumes a gate rate at the facility of \$50.00. The factors only come into play if the MCSWD changes rates for recycling or tipping fees at the District's facility.

Bag service will incur a monthly routing fee Kimble \$7.14 for the first year, increasing annually to a max of \$8.19 in year 5. Bags must be purchased from the supplier and disposal fees for these bags are paid in advance. The bag cost includes the disposal cost. Bags are charged at the time of delivery. Kimble - \$3.00 per bag, sold in rolls of 10 for \$30.00. Bags are purchased by roll as needed. If additional bulky items (refrigerator, yard waste, chair, etc.) are disposed additional fees per item will be incurred. (Attached) Customer will give advance notice waste hauler to inform of additional bulky items so the route sheet has the information for the driver. Drivers will have access to route service selected per address.

Republic routing fee \$12.03 increasing incrementally annually to \$13.80 in year 5. Cost per bag is \$2.70, 10 bags per roll totaling \$27.00.

Rumpke routing fee \$7.00 increasing incrementally annually to \$7.73 in year 5. Cost per bag is \$2.54, 10 per roll totaling \$25.40.

If a customer puts out one bag per week, total monthly bill will be routing fee, and additional fee for roll of bags each time a roll is ordered, and an additional fee each time a bulky item is

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disposed. Dave Hull pointed out the savings for bag hauling could be negated with the addition of many bulky items in the course of a year. All agreed the future push is to make unlimited service the most attractive program for all.

The recycling bins at the Buckeye Library will remain.

The county auditor provided the information on the numbers of all resident homes in the township (1900). It does not include the numbers from the city, or contiguous townships adjacent to the township. Opt out is at 6%. Approximately 100 households are eligible, based on this number. No service will be provided for those that are approved by trustees to opt out. All other properties will be included and charged based on level of service chosen.

After a hauler is chosen, there will be a mailing notice that goes out the residents from the trash hauler. In this information will be the process to opt out, and educational information how the roll out of the process will be executed in the township.

A decision selecting a trash hauler on the agenda at the September 26, 2019 regular meeting.

Trustee Monroe made the motion to adjourn, second by Trustee Pavlick. Roll: Monroe, yes; Pavlick, yes. Meeting adjourned 7:05pm.
