Chairman Rick Monroe called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. and led the pledge of allegiance. Trustee Monroe stated the meeting is being recorded for transcription purposes only.

Approval of Minutes

Fiscal Officer

Trustee Zieja stated we have no choice but to put on another Road's Levy. The cost of paving one mile of road, with necessary repairs has increased substantially, and revenue has not kept pace. Trustee Pavlick said it can cost up to \$180K to pave a mile of road.

The Annual Township Road Mileage Certification for the Ohio Department of Transportation was signed and returned in the enclosed envelope to the Medina County Engineer’s Office.

Hire Intern –The township board has been criticized in the past few years of not maintaining an informative website, of not being in touch with the residents about what direction the community would like to take in regard to trash, police service, and other matters of concern to the public. Fiscal Officer Russell has suggested we should put forth a greater effort to try and educate residents about the financial situation for the township roads. Chief Jason Creamer is interested in finding information about township sentiment on the direction they would like to see the Fire Department move, which will enable him to plan for future needs. Molly Russell is in her senior year at the University of Toledo, and will graduate in the spring with a dual major of accounting and marketing. I would like to take advantage of her skill sets in Social Media and use the next

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several months to explore how the township can incorporate better communication with the residents. She will also be administrative assistant for needs in zoning, fiscal office, work on the website as directed, and work with the Fire Department and the Road's Levy Information Group to work on survey's to educate and seek the residents input regarding township matters. We can use these next few months to explore the possible value of using social media platforms to reach township residents and ascertain if it is something the township would consider moving forward with. Suggested Pay rate is \$12.00 hour, not to exceed 20 hours per week. Trustee Pavlick said he wants to write up a job description and place it in The Post for a part-time job leading to full time to assist Dorothy in the office. He did not want to pay an intern to do the work. Trustee Zieja suggested before we move forward we have a job description in place. Discussion tabled until next month.

Inventory-Trustees and Chief Jason Creamer each given updated inventory lists current as of 12/31/20.

Fire Department –

Chief Jason Creamer reviewed for the trustees and submitted the annual report for 2020 and the current month Fire/EMS response reports (Attached)

In order to be fully operational with the MARCS Radio System, Chief Creamer requested the following additional units for the Fire Department since we have a compilation of equipment that uses the old 400 mhz operating system which will not be maintained by the sheriff going forward. Trustee Zieja inquired how the transition to the MARCS system was working. Chief Creamer stated everything seemed to be moving forward. Units in the trucks were programed by onsite representatives at no charge to us. Due to busy signals obtained in a snow storm, the state has added two more control channels. We pay user fees, we will not have to pay anything for the additional \$65K this will cost.

Motion to approve Cleveland Communications Inc. Requisition for 30 G4700-800 Single Band P25 Voice Pager totaling \$16,499.70; 29 G4/G5 Std Desktop Charger totaling \$2,320.00 and 1 G4G5 Charge Amplifier for \$145. Total Request \$18,964.70. Zach Lohr, an active member in good standing of the fire department for almost three years has requested the Fire Department to pay for additional training at Lorain Community College to become a Paramedic. In exchange for this education, he has signed an agreement to continue to provide service to the department for three years after completing his education and certification. If unable to complete this he will return money to the department, prorated for service completed.

RESOLUTION #21-01-17 Motion to approve Zach Lohr for Spring Term 2021 Paramedic Class at Lorain County Community College for \$2,161.95. Moved by Trustee Zieja, second by Trustee Pavlick. Roll: Monroe, yes; Pavlick, yes, Zieja yes.

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Dorothy stated there will be no zoning or BZA Meeting in January. The zoning commission asked Dorothy to inform the trustees they are still looking for an alternate for the Zoning Commission.

The changes in the fee schedule for cemeteries have been sent to the funeral homes.

Gentleman wants to make a cemetery stone for his uncle from countertop granite. Trustee Monroe said as long as it fits our measurement requirements. Other trustees see no problem, and Dorothy will submit pictures prior to installation.

Spieth Road – Medina Solid Waste Water called and a resident would like to put a green creek signs identifying the body of water, Mallet Creek. If they make sign and provide it, will the township put it up? Yes.

Cemetery – Flags fro the veteran’s office are ordered for the Memorial Day of 2021.

Consumer Gas has been on Station Road. People are wondering about this. Trustee Pavlick stated they are a Cooperative out of Orville, and are legitimate.

Dorothy provided a copy of all opt out submissions and a list of the first 100. There were several duplicates submitted. At this time she stated there are probably 150 submissions vying for the approved slots. Trustee Zieja has been over and over the list, and requested more eyes to proof and prevent mistakes.

Andy Kavc – Wanted to know if the list of people making the opt out list, was going to be finished soon. He wanted to know when the list would be available. Trustee Zieja said he would post it on the website.

Trustee Pavlick – EPA Septic Situation – We have been in contact with the health department about taking responsibility for the oversight of the township complex septic system. The EPA has issued increase guidance and requests for compliance on our system. Trustee Pavlick feels the system was originally approved by the EPA to meet our needs for all these years, and we should not incur a very large expense to unnecessarily update a functioning system. We have done monthly inspections and maintenance required for our current system. The Health Department inspected the site and reported we could be under the jurisdiction of the Health Department, but the drains from the Fire House cannot go into this system. The drains would still be under the jurisdiction of the EPA. Mike Pope from Litchfield stated their fire house, constructed 10 – 12 years ago drains into their septic. We did not have a system failure, the EPA has just changed what is currently acceptable for septic.

Attended a training for the Urban District which is required each year by the EPA, and filled out the required forms.

Trustee Zieja – All he had was the Opt Out list to go through.

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Trustee Monroe – Authorized Dobson Excavating to repair the park entrance and drive. A catch basin problem has also been repaired.

COVID Fund supplies have all been delivered. The picnic tables and trash cans for the park are waiting to be assembled.

Park – the electrical work for the cameras in the park is now completed.

Heating and Air Cooling systems have been installed in the town hall and Fire complex from the COVID Fund.

MVA in Park – a failure to maintain control of a trailer caused an MVA that wiped out three of the new trees planted in the park two days earlier. Two park signs were also destroyed. The individual responsible will be sent a bill for these items.

Fire Department Meeting Room – has been painted.

Stone Road – The guardrail damaged in an accident in early 2020 was repaired. The individual responsible will be billed for the total damages.

Station Generator – Dolphin Electric completed routine maintenance on the generator for the Fire Department.

Fire Department Bay area – the heating units in the bay are not all fully functioning. Over ½ of the units in the bay do not work. Trustee Monroe has received two quotes over \$10K. He feels these are high and will keep looking. The lights in the bay are also starting to fail. Looking into installing new LED bulbs.

Park Pond – Flow Landscape and Aquatics has been maintaining the park pond for many years. **Motion by Trustee Monroe, second by Trustee Pavlick to hire Flow Landscape and Aquatics for the 2021 maintenance contract for \$750.00.** Roll: Monroe, yes; Pavlick, yes; Zieja, yes.

Public Comment

Roger Mittler – Wondered if the township had a five-year plan on where we are planning to go? Are we looking to the possibility we may need another building for service, expansion of the fire department, the movement towards having the sheriff or police be funded by a law enforcement levy. Do we have a service department plan for roads? The fact no one bid on our snow plowing and salting for the year makes him wonder if we should be looking at doing this in house. Passing a road's levy will help determine how much money we have to plan for roads. Trustee Pavlick said that Valley City used about 30 to 40 hours a month for the sheriff's office for police staffing. The sheriff is the law enforcement for York Township. We pay taxes for that now. Until we pass a road's levy we cannot purchase a truck and pay a driver. What happens if the truck goes down

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during a storm? We have much to think about either direction. Not wanting to be someone who complains without offering a solution, Roger offered to be part of a five-year planning committee. Trustee Zieja said we need to be planning for the future and figure out where we are going, and plan for the changes, especially with the amount of houses that are going up.

Dave Hull – Wanted to have a workshop and invite residents to have input in the five-year plan. Trustee Zieja thought that was a good idea. Dave also said he thought Dorothy could benefit from some additional administrative support with the increased workflow in zoning.

T trustee Zieja moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 21-01-14

**A RESOLUTION TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION OF
THE QUESTION OF LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL TAX
IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION FOR THE
PURPOSE OF THE GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION,
RESURFACING, AND REPAIR OF STREETS, ROADS, AND BRIDGES IN
YORK TOWNSHIP, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS
5705.19(G), 5705.191, 5705.25 AND 5705.26 OF THE REVISED CODE, TO BE PLACED
ON THE BALLOT AT THE ELECTION ON MAY 4, 2021.**

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2021 this Board adopted Resolution No. 21-01-01 declaring it necessary to levy an additional tax of one and one-half (1.5) mills for the purpose of providing for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges in York Township, Medina County, Ohio pursuant to Section 5705.19(G) and/or 5707.191 of the Ohio Revised Code; and requesting the Medina County Auditor to certify the total current tax valuation of the Township and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that additional levy; and

WHEREAS, on January 14, 2021 the Medina County Auditor certified that the total current tax valuation of the Township is \$193,973,330 and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that one and one-half (1.5) mill additional levy would be \$282,300 per year during the life of the levy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of York Township, Medina County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1. This Board finds, determines and declares that the amount of taxes which may be raised by the Township, within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to meet the needs of York Township and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of that limitation for the purpose of providing for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads

and bridges in York Township, Medina County, Ohio and any and all purposes now or hereafter allowed under Section 5705.19(G) of the Revised Code at a rate not exceeding one and one-half (1.5) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifteen (\$0.15) cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years and which levy is an additional levy of one and one-half (1.5) mills, to be levied upon the entire territory of York Township, with 2021 the year in which the tax will first be levied and 2022 the calendar year in which the tax will first be collected, and the question of this additional levy shall be submitted to the electors of said York Township within the entire territory of York Township at the election to be held at the usual voting places within said York Township on the 4th day of May, 2021; as authorized by Sections, 5705.19(G), 5705.191, 5705.25 and 5705.26 of the Revised Code, Medina County being the only county in which York Township has territory.

Section 2. That said tax shall first be levied in 2021 and first be collected in 2022, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

Section 3. The Township Fiscal Officer is authorized and directed to deliver (i) a certified copy of Resolution No. 21-01-01 referred to in the first preamble of this resolution, (ii) the certificate of the Medina County Auditor referred to in the second preamble of this resolution, and (iii) a certified copy of this Resolution, to the Medina County Board of Elections and the Medina County Auditor no later than 90 days before the election on May 4, 2021.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board or committees, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its adoption.

Trustee Pavlick seconded the motion.


